Chime Deaf Specialist Multi-Disciplinary Team (0 - 25) Referral Pathway

Chime's Deaf Specialist Multi-Disciplinary Team (MDT) is a specialist team for children and young people (0-25) who are d/Deaf or hard of hearing. The MDT is a national service, which provides short-term, team-based input to support local services.

0 - 17 Years

Referrals can be made by Primary Care (SLTs, Psychologists or OTs) or by Children's Disability Network Team clinicians.

Access Criteria:

- 1. Children and young people (ages 0-17 years of age)
- 2. Permanent bilateral hearing loss in the moderate to profound range as evidenced by Audiogram.
- Presenting with additional needs directly related to being deaf, which cannot be met by their local service and require clinical input from a deaf specialist MDT.
- Active with a local Children's Disability Network Team or Primary Care (Psychology, SLT or OT).


18 - 25 Years

Referrals can be made by the Disability Manager

Access Criteria:

- 1. Adults aged 18-25 years of age.
- Permanent bilateral hearing loss in the moderate to profound range as evidenced by Audiogram.
- 3. Presenting with additional needs directly related to being deaf, which cannot be met by their local service and require clinical input from a deaf specialist MDT.
- 4. Active with a local service*.

*Please note that the Deaf Specialist MDT's involvement may be limited where there is no clinical team to carry on a longer-term piece of input.
