# What happens?

#### Information for parents:

There are a number of information stands and workshop sessions facilitated by experts on topics such as audiology, hearing technologies, communication, entitlements and support services.

## Sharing for parents:

There are ample opportunities for parents to share their experiences and learn from each other.

#### Fun for children:

Children aged 14 years and under are welcome at the weekend, and they can engage in a wide range of fun activities while their parents are attending workshop sessions.



# Where is it on?

The Midlands Park Hotel is in Portlaoise town, ideally located only 1 hour from Dublin, 1.5 hours from Cork and just five minutes' walk from Portlaoise Train Station.

The hotel offers a number of family rooms (limited to four family members, a supplement may be incurred if additional accommodation is required). Residents also have access to a fitness suite and swimming pool.

The cost of attending the weekend is €70 per adult (16 years and over) and €40 per child for the weekend. All accommodation, meals, information pack and children's activities are provided by Chime.
